EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It is the policy of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education to grant each public technical college the authority to abate out-of-state tuition rates for technical college students receiving privately funded scholarship aid consistent with South Carolina Commission on Higher Education policy. Tuition shall be abated for purposes of meeting in-state workforce development needs. The area commission of each technical college electing to participate in this process will be responsible for establishing and approving policy for the local administration of the tuition abatement.
