EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It is the policy of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education that the technical colleges under its jurisdiction shall remain commuter institutions without residential facilities (with the exception of Denmark Technical College which may continue to provide residential facilities for its students).

An institution may, with prior approval of the State Tech Board, renovate existing dormitory facilities to provide overnight accommodations for Continuing Education Programs such as seminars and workshops.
