When it is determined that The Center for Accelerated Technology Training pre-employment training is to be conducted in a temporary facility in a community, it is then the responsibility of that community to provide a suitable building at the community's expense.

Further, the community will be responsible for one-half (1/2) of the cost of utilities (water, gas electricity, local telephone service, and janitorial service) associated with the pre-employment training. Such costs will only be on a temporary basis to meet the needs of a particular program.

All other costs of pre-employment training including instructor salaries, materials, tools, supplies, equipment installation, and one-half (1/2) of the utility costs will be borne by the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education, subject to the rules and regulations pertaining thereto.
