Hall most recently served as the dean of Business and Public Service at Central Carolina Technical College in Sumter, South Carolina. In addition to his work at Central Carolina, he serves as a reserve deputy with Richland County Sheriff's Department. Before teaching at Central Carolina, Hall taught at Denmark Technical College and previously served as a corrections officer and training resource officer for the South Carolina Department of Corrections.

Hall holds a Master of Public Administration, with a concentration in Criminal Justice from Jacksonville State University, a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from the University of South Carolina and a Doctorate of Management in Community College Policy and Administration Degree at University of Maryland University College.

He was named the 2014 South Carolina Governor's Professor of the Year for two-year colleges. He is also a recipient of the 2013 E. C. "Red" Kneece Instructional Excellence Award presented by the Central Carolina Foundation and the 2004 Central Carolina's Educator of the Year.
